- How are curriculum, instruction and assessment integrated in the design of professional learning opportunities?
- How does participation in professional learning enhance professional practice?
- How are educators collaborating to support their professional growth?

What strategies, procedures and/or processes will you use to address this essential condition?

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Outcomes

What will you accept as evidence that this essential condition is being addressed?

- Are effective teacher mentorship and coaching practices in place?
- Is risk-taking and innovation evident among educators, instructional leaders and the school board?
- Are promising practices documented and shared?
- Are coordinated, collaborative and comprehensive professional learning plans in place to support implementation? Are self-identified professional learning needs and preferences of participants being met?
- Do teachers have access to and are they participating in a variety of learning opportunities that address their needs and preferences? Are teachers reflecting on how their professional learning experiences are influencing their professional practice?
- Are teachers engaging in ongoing career-long professional growth?
- What other evidence would you accept for your context?
